AN ACT EXTENDING TO FAMILY MEMBERS THE REQUIREMENT THAT A LIFE COMPANY MUST OBTAIN THE SIGNATURE BY ANY PERSON TO BE INSURED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 175 Section 123 is hereby amended by deleting the
2 following words: — and provided, further, that such a company
3 may issue a single policy on the lives of any two or more members
4 of a family on an application signed by either parent, a step-
5 parent, or by a husband or wife. For the purposes of this
6 paragraph members of a family shall mean husband, wife,
7 children, adopted children, or step-children.
