## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT REQUIRING AN AUDIT OF THE MASSACHUSETTS TURNPIKE AUTHORITY TO BE CONDUCTED BY THE STATE AUDITOR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter three hundred and  
2 fifty-four of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-two or any  
3 other special or general law to the contrary any increase in tolls  
4 for the use of the turnpike approved by the Massachusetts  
5 Turnpike Authority during nineteen hundred and eighty-nine or  
6 nineteen hundred and ninety shall not take effect prior to ninety  
7 days after the completion of an audit conducted by the State  
8 Auditor authorized under the provisions section twelve of chapter  
9 eleven of the General Laws. Said audit shall be conducted for the  
10 purpose of reviewing all accounts and activities directly related  
11 to the operations of said authority during the years of nineteen  
12 hundred and eighty-eight and nineteen hundred and eighty-nine.
