AN ACT REQUIRING THE INSTALLATION OF "HARD-WIRE" SMOKE DETECTORS IN PUBLIC HOUSING UNITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 121B of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 32A the following section: —
- 3 Section 32B. Every housing authority shall install approved
- 4 hard-wire smoke detectors in each unit of its housing projects and
- 5 all costs shall be paid for by the Commonwealth.
