AN ACT RELATING TO POLICE OFFICERS ASSIGNED TO POLLING PLACES DURING ELECTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 72 of Chapter 54 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by adding the following sentence: —
- 3 For purposes of this section, a polling place shall be considered
- 4 the building housing one or more precincts.
