AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE FURTHER CONTROL OF POLLING PLACES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 65 of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the
3 word "place" in line 14 the following sentence: — No person or
4 materials intended to influence or ascertain the location of the
5 voter shall be allowed within one hundred and fifty feet of the
6 building entrance door to the polling place.
