AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRATION OF VOTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 51, Section 38 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by adding the following paragraph: —
- 3 The registrars shall, upon the written application and with
- 4 proper identification of a registered voter, remove such person
- 5 from the annual register of qualified voters, when the registered
- 6 voter so requests, because of moving to another City or Town,
- 7 moving to another State or Country, because of religious beliefs,
- 8 or for any other reason. Such written application shall be attached
- 9 to the original affidavit of registration and shall be preserved as
- 10 a permanent record.
