AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE LOTTERY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 35 of Chapter 10 of the General Laws, as set forth in
2 the 1986 Official Edition, is herewith amended by striking out lines
3 13 through 17, and substituting in their place the following: —

4 c) one percent of the balance of said fund, as determined by
5 the comptroller, on June first and December first of each year,
6 shall be disbursed to programs for the rehabilitation of compulsive
7 gamblers;

8 d) ninety-nine percent of the balance of said fund, as determined
9 by the comptroller, on June first and December first of each year,
10 shall be credited to the Local Aid Fund established under the
11 provisions of section two D of chapter twenty-nine, and shall be
12 distributed to the several cities and towns in accordance with the
13 provisions of section eighteen C of chapter fifty-eight.
