By Mr. Moore of Uxbridge, petition of Richard T. Moore relative to the issuance of motor vehicle operator licenses without charge for persons sixty-five years of age and older. Public Safety.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ISSUANCE OF MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR LICENSES FOR PERSONS SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE AND OLDER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 33, of Chapter 90, of the Massachusetts
2 General Laws, as appearing in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby
3 amended in line 152, by inserting after the word "thereof." the
4 following sentence: — No fee shall be collected for a license or
5 renewal from a person aged 65 years or older.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
