AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT RIGHTS OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE PAROLE BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
2 following section 29L, the following new section: —

3 Section 28M. Notwithstanding any provisions of sections one
4 through twenty-eight inclusive, to the contrary, any employee of
5 the Parole Board, classified under Group 4, who has performed
6 service in the department of correction, and/or parole board, for
7 not less than twenty years shall, at his/her own request, be retired
8 by said retirement board.

9 The retirement allowances under this section shall be the same
10 as those provided for in paragraph (C) of subdivision (3) of section
11 twenty-six.
