AN ACT RELATIVE TO BEVERAGE CONTAINERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 94 of the General Laws, as most recently appearing
- 2 in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out
- 3 section 324 and inserting in place thereof the following section: —
- 4 Section 324. No dealer shall sell or offer for sale in the
- 5 commonwealth containers connected to each other by a separate
- 6 holding device constructed of any material other than a
- 7 biodegradable paper product.
