### AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE AGE OF CHILDREN WHO MAY PERFORM VOLUNTEER SERVICES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 60 of Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out the last paragraph and inserting in place
- 3 thereof the following two paragraphs: —
- 4 This section and section eighty-six shall not be deemed to
- 5 prohibit children fourteen to sixteen years of age from voluntarily
- 6 performing services in a non-profit hospital after regular school
- 7 hours, but not after 8:00 post meridiem, and further this section
- 8 and section eighty-six shall not be deemed to prohibit children
- 9 thirteen years of age from voluntarily performing services in a
- 10 non-profit hospital after regular school hours, but not after 5:30
- 11 post meridiem.
- 12 Such children thirteen to sixteen years of age voluntarily
- 13 performing services in a non-profit hospital will receive an
- 14 orientation to such non-profit hospital and will receive
- 15 supervision for any and all such voluntarily performed services.
