AN ACT RELATIVE TO A PERCENTAGE OF MONIES TO BE RETAINED BY THE REGISTER OF DEEDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 3 of Chapter 64D of the General Laws of the
- 2 Commonwealth of Massachusetts is amended by inserting therein
- 3 after the third paragraph the following paragraph: —
- 4 Each month there shall be retained by the register of deeds for
- 5 each county and subdivision thereof an amount equal to .01
- 6 percent of the monies received by him/her for the sale of such
- 7 stamps. The monies so retained shall be used by the said register
- 8 of deeds for the development, implementation and maintenance
- 9 of modern data processing methods and mechanisms within the
- 10 registry of deeds.
