## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-One.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A FOURTH ASSISTANT CLERK IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF HAMPSHIRE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 10 of Chapter 218 of the General Laws  
2 is hereby amended by striking out the line reading "district court  
3 of Hampshire" in the third paragraph and inserting the words  
4 "district court of Hampshire" in the fourth paragraph, after the  
5 line reading "district court of Northern Norfolk".

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
