

HOUSE No. 4567

By Mr. Nagle of Northampton, petition of William P. Nagle, Jr., relative to permitting the issuance of three day hunting and fishing licenses to non-residents. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

AN ACT PERMITTING THE ISSUANCE OF THREE DAY HUNTING AND FISHING LICENSES TO NON-RESIDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The third paragraph of section 11 of chapter 131
2 of the General Laws, as appearing in section 232 of chapter 572
3 of the acts of 1980, is hereby amended by striking out the second
4 sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: —
5 The amounts of the fees for the following licenses shall be
6 determined pursuant to the aforementioned chapter seven
7 provision: — a big game hunting license which shall apply to the
8 hunting of all game including deer and bear; a small game hunting
9 license, which shall apply to game excepting deer and bear; a
10 nonresident small game hunting license and good for three
11 consecutive days specified on the license; a fishing license covering
12 all the inland waters and good for seven consecutive days specified
13 on the license; a fishing license good for three consecutive days
14 specified on the license.

1 SECTION 2. Clause (3) of the second paragraph of section 31
2 of said chapter 131, as most recently amended by chapter 110 of
3 the acts of 1979, is hereby further amended by striking out, in lines
4 5 and 6, the words "and good only on commercial shooting
5 preserves".
