AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE POLICE CAREER INCENTIVE PAY PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 108M of chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 3 Notwithstanding any other provisions of this section or section
- 4 one hundred and eight L or any other general or special law or
- 5 rule or regulation to the contrary, any police officer who has
- 6 satisfactorily completed the educational requirements under the
- 7 provisions of this chapter, as originally enacted, and subsequently
- 8 became ineligible due to the later acceptance of the amended
- 9 version thereto by the city or town in which such officer was
- 10 employed, shall nevertheless be entitled to all the benefits that the
- 11 said officer would have been entitled to had the city or town not
- 12 accepted the amended version which disqualified such officer.
