AN ACT PROVIDING FOR SPEEDY PROCESSING OF SCHEDULES OF WAGES UNDER THE PREVAILING WAGE LAW, SO-CALLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 27 of chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting after the word "made" in line 22, as
- 3 appearing in the 1988 Official Edition, the following sentence: —
- 4 The commissioner, or his designee in a local office, shall, within
- 5 ten days after such determination send by fax machine, modem
- 6 or other electronic system such wage rates that are applicable and
- 7 shall update such rates whenever labor settlements affect them.
