AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING COGENERATION FACILITIES AS RELATED TO THE INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT OF MUNICIPALITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 40D of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out paragraph (c $\frac{1}{2}$), as appearing in the 1988
3 Official Edition, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 paragraph: —

5 (c $\frac{1}{2}$) "Cogeneration facility", any electrical generating unit, or
6 facilities used in connection with the transmission of electricity,
7 which produces electrical energy or steam for one or more users,
8 one of whom shall be a public or nonprofit user.
