AN ACT TO PROVIDE SERVICES FOR THOSE PERSONS WITH MENTAL RETARDATION WHO ARE FIFTY YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 19B of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 18 the following section: —
- 3 Services will be guaranteed for persons with mental retardation
- 4 fifty years of age and over.
