- Resolved, That a special commission to consist of two 1
- members of the senate, three members of the house of
- representatives and eight persons to be appointed by the governor,
- two of whom shall be representatives of the business community,
- two of whom shall be employees of the department of
- environmental protection, one of whom shall be a representative
- of a national fire prevention association, two of whom shall be
- members of organized labor (pipe trades, U.A.), and one shall be
- a member of the contractors association (G.B.P.H.C.C.) is hereby
- established for the purpose of making an investigation and study
- including but not limited to the existence of any health hazards
- 12 from sprinkler systems and the feasibility and cost effectiveness
- of requiring back-flow protection for such systems. 13
- Said commission shall report to the general court the results 14
- of its investigation and study and its recommendations, if any, 15
- together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such 16
- recommendations into effect by filing the same with the clerk of
- the house of representatives on or before the first Wednesday in 18
- May nineteen hundred and ninety-two.
