AN ACT INCREASING THE SPEED LIMIT TO SIXTY-FIVE MILES PER HOUR ON CERTAIN PORTIONS OF THE MASSACHUSETTS TURNPIKE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Paragraph (i) of section 5 of chapter 354 of the acts of 1952
- 2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:—
- 3 Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter or any
- 4 other contrary provision in the General Laws or any rule or
- 5 regulation of the authority, the speed limit on the turnpike shall
- 6 be sixty-five miles per hour between the New York border and
- 7 the Westfield city line and on said turnpike between the
- 8 Wilbraham town line and the Oxford town line. Said authority
- 9 shall erect appropriate signs and markings indicating the different
- 10 speed zones as authorized by this act.
