AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALE AND INSPECTION OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Every new or used motor vehicle sold by an auto dealer, shall
- 2 be inspected and shall receive a Massachusetts Registry of Motor
- 3 Vehicles inspection sticker prior to delivery. The inspection sticker
- 4 shall reflect the current month in which said vehicle was sold. The
- 5 cost of such inspection sticker shall be borne by the dealer.
