

HOUSE No. 5079

By Mr. Lionett of Worcester, petition of David J. Lionett relative to the appointment of former elected state officials to certain public positions. State Administration.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE APPOINTMENT OF FORMER ELECTED STATE OFFICIALS TO CERTAIN PUBLIC POSITIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 268A of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after section 5, the following section: —

3 Section 5A. No former elected state official shall be eligible for
4 appointment to any permanent, non civil service position with the
5 commonwealth for at least ninety days after the date of expiration
6 of the term of office for which he had been elected, and until public
7 notice of the intention to fill the vacancy in said position has been
8 posted at least thirty days prior to such appointment. Said notice
9 shall be filed with the secretary of state and a copy thereof posted
10 in the executive office for administration and finance and shall
11 contain a job description of the position, the salary that will be
12 paid to the new appointee and the annual salary of the last
13 occupant to hold the position.
