

HOUSE No. 5250

By Mr. Vellucci of Cambridge, petition of Francis H. Duehay and others that parking control officers be included in the law relative to assault and battery upon certain public servants. Criminal Justice.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO ASSAULT AND BATTERY UPON CERTAIN PUBLIC SERVANTS.

1 *Whereas*, the deferred operation of this amendment to Section
2 13D of Chapter 265 of the General Laws would tend to defeat
3 its purpose, which is to immediately ensure the safety and well
4 being of all parking control officers, therefore it is hereby declared
5 to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation
6 of the public peace.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 13D of Chapter 265 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the 1989 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after
3 the word “constable” in line 2, the words: — parking control
4 officer.
