AN ACT PROVIDING FOR DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION PLATES FOR VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by section 1 of chapter 365 of the acts of 1990 is hereby
- 3 further amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 4 The registrar shall furnish at his office at no less than cost to
- 5 veterans of foreign wars upon presentation of satisfactory
- 6 evidence of such veteran of foreign wars status as determined by
- 7 the registrar, distinctive registration plates for one pleasure
- 8 passenger vehicle owned and principally operated by said
- 9 individual.
