AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF REVERE TO INCREASE THE PENALTY FOR BREACH OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AND REGULATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 21 of Chapter 40 of
2 the Massachusetts General Laws the City of Revere may make
3 such ordinances not repugnant to law as they may judge most
4 conducive to their welfare, which shall be binding upon all
5 inhabitants thereof and all persons within their limits. They may,
6 except as provided for by Section 21 of Chapter 40 M.G.L., affix
7 penalties for breaches thereof not exceeding one thousand dollars
8 for each offense, which shall inure to the City or to such uses as
9 it may direct. Notwithstanding the provisions of any special law
10 to the contrary, fines shall be recovered by indictment or on
11 complaint before a district court, or by noncriminal disposition
12 in accordance with Section twenty-one D.
