AN ACT AMENDING CHAPTER 201 OF THE ACTS AND RESOLVES OF 1945.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 201 of the Acts of 1945 is
2 amended, in the first sentence, line three thereof, by deleting the
3 term "twelve members" and by inserting therein the term "twenty
4 members".

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
