AN ACT RELATIVE TO RETAINED REVENUES FOR THE OFFICE FOR CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 3 of Chapter 28A of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by adding after paragraph four the following
- 3 paragraph: —
- 4 Without further appropriation, the Office may expend all
- 5 revenues generated by licensing fees and day care lists for the
- 6 purposes set forth in this chapter.
