AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF THE CLINTON LANDFILL AS THE PRIMARY BACKUP LANDFILL FOR THE BOSTON HARBOR CLEAN-UP.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 372 of the acts of 1984 is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section 26 the following section: —
3 Section 26A. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or
4 special law or this act to the contrary, the landfill situated in the
5 town of Clinton and owned by the Authority shall be the primary
6 backup landfill for sludge, grits, screening, pellets or other matter
7 resulting from or pertaining to the Boston Harbor clean-up, so-
8 called; provided, however, that said town of Clinton shall be
9 compensated therefor in an amount to be agreed upon by said
10 town and the Authority.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
