AN ACT RELATIVE TO HOUSE TRAILERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by inserting after the definition of "Heavy duty
3 platform trailer", as appearing in the 1988 Official Edition, the
4 following definition: —

5 "House trailer", a vehicle having no motive power of its own,
6 originally designed or permanently altered and equipped for
7 human habitation which is not used to transport property other
8 than property used for human habitation or camping purposes.
9 A trailer designed primarily to transport property which has been
10 temporarily altered or equipped for human habitation shall not
11 be deemed to be a house trailer.

1 SECTION 2. The first paragraph of section 19 of said chap-
2 ter 90, as appearing in section 4 of chapter 208, of the acts of 1990,
3 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "truck", in line 9,
4 the words: , auto home, house trailer.

1 SECTION 3. Said first paragraph of said section 19 of said
2 chapter 90 is hereby further amended by striking out the second
3 sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: —
4 The overall length of a semi-trailer unit or a tractor-trailer com-
5 bination, or house trailer and tow vehicle, wherever used, may
6 exceed thirty-three feet but shall not exceed sixty feet, except as
7 otherwise specifically authorized by this section or authorized by
8 a special permit granted as aforesaid.
