AN ACT DESIGNATING A PORTION OF STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 107 IN THE CITY OF REVERE IN MEMORY OF RICHARD STANCHI.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The portion of state highway, Route 107, in the city of Revere,
- 2 beginning at Brown Circle and extending to the Saugus line, shall
- 3 be designated and known as the Richard Stanchi Memorial
- 4 Highway, in memory of Richard Stanchi, a state department of
- 5 public works employee who was killed in the line of duty. Suitable
- 6 markers bearing such designation shall be erected thereat by the
- 7 department of public works in compliance with the standards of
- 8 said department.
