AN ACT RELATIVE TO BICYCLE TRAFFIC ON COMMERCIAL STREET IN THE TOWN OF PROVINCETOWN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section  
2 eleven B of chapter eighty-five of the General Laws or any other  
3 law to the contrary, the town of Provincetown is hereby  
4 authorized to adopt rules providing for the operation of bicycle  
5 traffic on Commercial Street in said town relative to the direction  
6 and travel and passing on said street.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
