AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CERTAIN REVOLVING FUND IN THE TOWN OF OAK BLUFFS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section fifty-three of chapter  
2 forty-four of the General Laws, the town of Oak Bluffs may  
3 establish in the town treasury a revolving fund which shall be kept  
4 separate and apart from all other monies by the town treasurer  
5 and in which shall be deposited the receipts from the sale or sales  
6 of the Lake Street fire station, fire station number three and fire  
7 station number four. The principal and interest thereon shall be  
8 expanded without further appropriation under the direction of  
9 said town treasurer for the repayment of any borrowing incurred  
10 as the result of the construction of fire department facilities or  
11 the purchase of fire trucks.
