2 the recess of the General Court to make an investigation and study
3 of House documents numbered 1525 and 3729, relative to
4 beverage container redemption centers.

5 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results
6 of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
7 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
8 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk
9 of the Senate on or before the last Monday in October, nineteen
10 hundred and ninety-one.
