2 Affairs be authorized to sit during the recess of the General Court
3 to make an investigation and study of House document num-
4 bered 4356, relative to a drug and health education program to
5 be run by the National Guard.

6 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results
7 of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
8 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
9 recommendations into effect, by filing same with the Clerk of the
10 House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday in
11 December, nineteen hundred and ninety-one.
