AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN BRIDGE IN THE TOWN OF RAYNHAM AS
THE ALBERT F. PORTER BRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The bridge on state highway Route 44 over state highway
- 2 Route 24 in the town of Raynham shall be designated and known
- 3 as the Albert F. Porter Bridge in honor of Albert F. Porter who
- 4 served the town of Rayham in public office for over fifty years.
- 5 Suitable markers bearing such designation shall be attached
- 6 thereto by the department of public works in compliance with the
- 7 standards of said department.
