AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF HINSDALE TO HOLD A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPROVING AN APPOINTED BOARD OF HEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the terms of section 21 of
2 Chapter 41 of the General Laws to the contrary, the Town of
3 Hinsdale is hereby authorized to place the following question on
4 a ballot at a special election to be held no later than sixty (60)
5 days following the effective date of this act:

6 "Shall the Town vote to have its Selectmen appoint a Board
7 of Health?"

1 SECTION 2. If this question is approved by the voters at this
2 special election the aforesaid board shall be appointed as soon
3 as said election results are official. Said appointments shall be
4 made in a manner so that one member's term shall expire in each
5 year, a full term of membership shall be for three years.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon approval.
