To The Honorable House of Representatives:

Pursuant to Article LVI, as amended by Article XC, Section 3, of the Amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, I am returning to you for amendment House Bill No. 2984, entitled "An Act Authorizing Minors to Pump Gasoline."

While I agree with the intent of the bill, as drafted, House Bill No. 2984 requires amendment for consistency with the text of the current statute. In particular, the amendment contained in this bill should not be given a separate numerical sub-part designation (as it currently reads).

I therefore recommend that House Bill No. 2984 be amended by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

Section 61 of Chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "vehicles", in line 29, the following clause:- ; or in any gasoline service establishment, provided, however that such minor may be employed solely to dispense gasoline and oil and to provide courtesy service outside of the service bay area of any such gasoline service establishment.
