

By Mr. Connolly of Everett, petition of Edward G. Connolly and Thomas F. Birmingham (with the approval of the mayor, board of aldermen and common council) for legislation to exempt the position of chief of police of the city of Everett from the provisions of civil service law. Public Service. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT TO EXEMPT THE POSITION OF CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE CITY OF EVERETT FROM THE PROVISIONS OF CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The position of Police Chief in the City of Everett
2 shall be exempt from the provisions of chapter thirty-one of the
3 General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of section one shall not impair the
2 civil service status of any person holding the position of Police
3 Chief in the City of Everett on the effective date of this act.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
