AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE SECRETARY TO AUTHORIZE THE SOLEMNIZATION OF A CERTAIN MARRIAGE.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to  
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately authorize the  
3 solemnization of a certain marriage, therefore it is hereby declared  
4 to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation  
5 of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirty-nine of chapter  
2 two hundred and seven of the General Laws, the state secretary  
3 may authorize in the manner set forth under said section thirty-  
4 nine, the solemnization of a marriage by the Honorable Ann York  
5 McNamara, as she is justice of the peace in the state of New Jersey,  
6 in the town of Belmont on October thirteenth, nineteen hundred  
7 and ninety-one between Sara Christine Tracy, of the town of  
8 Belmont, and James Robert Arone, of the town of Belmont, and  
9 the state secretary shall issue to said Ann York McNamara in her  
10 capacity as aforesaid a certificate of such authorization.
