AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE SECRETARY TO AUTHORIZE THE SOLEMNIZATION OF A CERTAIN MARRIAGE.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately authorize the
3 solemnization of a certain marriage, therefore it is hereby declared
4 to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation
5 of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirty-nine of chapter
2 two hundred and seven of the General Laws, the state secretary
3 may authorize in the manner set forth under said section thirty-
4 nine, the solemnization of a marriage by Joseph J. Machera, as
5 he is an attorney in the commonwealth, in the city of Beverly, on
6 October twentieth, nineteen hundred and ninety-one between
7 Benita R. Corrao and John J. Carey, both of the city of Revere,
8 and the state secretary shall issue to said Joseph J. Machera in
9 his capacity as aforesaid a certificate of such authorization.
