### AN ACT TO INCREASE THE THRESHOLD REQUIRING BIDS FOR PUBLIC CONTRACTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 22 of chapter 7 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by  
3 striking the words “five hundred dollars” in line 22 and inserting  
4 in place thereof the words “one thousand dollars”.

1 SECTION 2. Section 36A of chapter 30 of the General Laws,  
2 as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by  
3 striking the words “five hundred”, in line 10, and inserting in place  
4 thereof the words “fifteen hundred”.

1 SECTION 3. Section 36A of said chapter 30, as so appearing,  
2 is hereby amended by striking the words “nine hundred and fifty”,  
3 in line 12, and inserting in place thereof the words “three  
4 thousand.”

1 SECTION 4. Section 36A of said chapter 30, as so appearing,  
2 is hereby amended by striking the words “six thousand”, in lines  
3 11 and 14, and inserting in place thereof, in each instance where  
4 they appear, the words “fifteen thousand”.

1 SECTION 5. Section 39M of said chapter 30, as appearing in  
2 the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking the words  
3 “five thousand dollars”, in lines 6 and 10, and inserting in place  
4 thereof, in each instance where they appear, the words “ten  
5 thousand dollars.”
