## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-One.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LYNN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Article 3 of the charter of the city of Lynn which is on file in  
2 the office of the archivist of the commonwealth, as provided in  
3 section 12 of chapter 43B of the General Laws, is hereby amended  
4 by striking out paragraph (a) of section 3-7 and inserting in place  
5 thereof the following paragraph: —  
6 (a) Appointment after Expiration of Term — No city councillor  
7 shall hold any compensative appointive city office or city  
8 employment during his term and until two years following the  
9 expiration of the term for which he was elected. Notwithstanding  
10 the foregoing, a former city councillor may serve as chief of staff  
11 or administrative aide to the mayor. This section shall not prohibit  
12 a city officer or city employee who has taken a leave of absence  
13 from such office or employment from resuming his duties as such  
14 following service as a city councillor.
