AN ACT RELATIVE TO CLOTHING ALLOWANCES TO CERTAIN RECIPIENTS OF AID TO FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Item 4403-2000 of section 2 of chapter 133 of the
2 acts of 1992 is hereby amended by inserting after the word
3 "ninety", in line 26, the following words: — and shall be
4 implemented by means of a voucher program whereby said
5 department shall reimburse providers up to the amount of such
6 clothing allowance and said department shall make rules and
7 regulations necessary to implement said voucher program.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of July first, nineteen
2 hundred and ninety-three.
