AN ACT RELATIVE TO PUBLIC RECORDS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Clause twenty-sixth of section 7 of chapter 4 of the General
- 2 Laws, as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended
- 3 by striking out sub-clause (c) and inserting in place thereof the
- 4 following sub-clause: —
- 5 (c) personnel, medical and other data relating to a specifically
- 6 named individual, the disclosure of which would constitute a
- 7 clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.
