

By Mr. Rauschenbach, petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 943) of Henri S. Rauschenbach for legislation to authorize the Oak Bluffs Water Department to supply water to the Martha's Vineyard Airport. Natural Resources and Agriculture.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE OAK BLUFFS WATER DEPARTMENT TO SUPPLY WATER TO THE MARTHA'S VINEYARD AIRPORT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 143 of
2 the acts of 1906 or any other general or special law to the contrary,
3 the Edgartown Water Company, its successors and assigns, shall
4 not exercise any power to take, by purchase or otherwise, any
5 lands, rights of way, or easements on lands which are necessary
6 for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, and repairing
7 conduits, pipes, and other works to transport water from the Oak
8 Bluffs Water Department to the Martha's Vineyard Airport.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 8 of
2 chapter 165 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1990 Official
3 Edition, or any other general or special law to the contrary, the
4 Oak Bluffs Water Department is hereby authorized, if it so
5 chooses, to construct, maintain, and repair conduits, pipes, and
6 other works necessary to transport water from the Oak Bluffs
7 Water Department to the Martha's Vineyard Airport and may dig
8 up and open streets, lanes, highways, and other lands situated
9 within the Town of Edgartown for the purpose of constructing,
10 maintaining, and repairing such conduits, pipes, and other works.

1 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any general or special law to
2 the contrary, the Martha's Vineyard Airport Commission of the

3 County of Dukes County is hereby authorized to transfer certain
4 land within the Airport to the Oak Bluffs Water Department for
5 use as a future well site of the Town of Oak Bluffs.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
