AN ACT RELATIVE TO DEFINING FALLOW DEER AS AN AGRICULTURAL COMMODITY WITHIN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 128 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended in Section 1A by inserting after the word "poultry," the
3 words "fallow deer,".

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended in Section 1 as it appears in the Official 1988 Edition
3 by inserting in line sixteen after the word "poultry," the words
4 "fallow deer,".

1 SECTION 3. Chapter 61A of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended in Section 1 by inserting after the word "poultry," the
3 words "fallow deer,".

1 SECTION 4. Chapter 90 of the General Laws as most recently
2 amended pursuant to Chapter 128 of the Acts of 1992 is hereby
3 further amended in Section 1 in the definition of "Farmer" by
4 inserting after the word "poultry," the words "fallow deer,".

1 SECTION 5. Chapter 59 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended in Section 5, clause twenty-first, by inserting after the
3 word "swine," the words "fallow deer," and hereby further
4 amended in the same chapter, section 8A by inserting after the
5 word "swine," the words "fallow deer,".
