By Mr. Keating, petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1033) of William R. Keating, John H. Rogers, Richard R. Tisei and Leonard J. Sacco for legislation to provide distinctive license plates for members of the Ancient and Honorable Artillery Company. Public Safety.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR DISTINCTIVE LICENSE PLATES FOR MEMBERS OF
THE ANCIENT AND HONORABLE ARTILLERY COMPANY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2 of Chapter 90 of the Massachusetts General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 inserting after line 324 the following paragraph: —

4 The registrar of motor vehicles is hereby directed to establish
5 for members of the Ancient and Honorable Artillery Company
6 of Massachusetts a distinctive registration plate for one pleasure
7 vehicle owned and principally used by a qualified member. Such
8 plate shall depict an appropriate symbol and shall be issued only
9 to members of the Ancient and Honorable Artillery Company of
10 Massachusetts.
