

By Mr. Keating, petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1132) of William R. Keating for legislation to authorize the State Retirement Board to credit years of service of state employees who are former employees of the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority system for pension purposes upon payment of the amount of their creditable service. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE RETIREMENT BOARD TO CREDIT YEARS OF SERVICE OF STATE EMPLOYEES WHO ARE FORMER EMPLOYEES OF THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY SYSTEM FOR PENSION PURPOSES UPON PAYMENT OF THE AMOUNT OF THEIR CREDITABLE SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the
2 state retirement board is hereby authorized and directed to credit
3 the term of service of any former employee of the Massachusetts
4 Bay Transportation Authority for pension purposes in computing
5 the retirement allowance of such employee; provided, however,
6 that he pays into the fund of said system such amount with interest
7 as said retirement board may determine as being equal to that
8 which he would have paid into said fund had he been a member
9 in service during said term in accordance with the provisions of
10 chapter thirty-two of the General Laws.

11 The Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority retirement
12 board shall pay its share of each pension to the state retirement
13 system in proportion to the number of years of service to the
14 Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority that each employee
15 is entitled.
