AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DEFINITION OF "VETERAN" FOR THE PURPOSES OF CHAPTER 32.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 32 of the Massachusetts General Laws (1990 Edition)
2 is amended in Section 1 thereof by adding at the end of the final
3 paragraph the following: — "or (d) was a member of a retirement
4 system before taking a military leave of absence, performed ninety
5 days of active service, was discharged under honorable conditions
6 and was reinstated or reemployed in the same or similar position
7 upon discharge".
