## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Three.

### RESOLVE ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL COMMISSION TO REVIEW EXPENDITURES ON THE CENTRAL ARTERY/THIRD HARBOR TUNNEL PROJECT.

1 *Resolved*, That there is hereby established a special commis-  
2 sion to consist of three members of the senate, three members of  
3 the house of representatives and three members to be appointed  
4 by the governor, one of whom shall be an employee of the state  
5 auditor, for the purpose of conducting an investigation and review  
6 of expenditures relating to the Central Artery/Third Harbor  
7 Tunnel Project to ensure that such expenditures are reasonable.

8 The state auditor shall assist the commission in gathering the  
9 information necessary for such investigation and review.

10 Said commission shall report the results of its investigation and  
11 review to the general court by filing the same with the clerk of  
12 the senate, together with recommendations, if any, and prepared  
13 legislation necessary to carry out such recommendations. Said  
14 commission shall file a preliminary report within ninety days after  
15 its initial meeting and thereafter annually until the said project  
16 is completed. The commission shall file its final report within  
17 ninety days after the completion of said project.
